**POLICY F19**

**LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY STUDENTS**

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**Policy**

It is the policy of the Washington Northeast and Cabot and Twinfield Union School District to ensure that students whose primary or dominant language is not English, and who therefore have limited-English proficiency (LEP), have equitable access to school programs as required by law.

**Implementation**

The superintendent or his or her designee shall be responsible for developing and implementing procedures to comply with federal and state laws which define standards for serving LEP students.
